

So lets get started!!


# **BEST CAMERA FOR CREATING VIDEOS**

It comes with great camera quality, fantastic autofocus and you can pause and play the video to reduce number of clips.

Even if you are having a decent mobile it comes with at least 8MP camera, so great to use!!


This is a very sturdy Tripod which can last for long time. You may get very cheap tripods too but may last only for coupe of months.

# Lighting

You may have the best camera, but if the lighting is not good then even DSLR cant give the best video!!

1<sup>st</sup> check the video quality by increasing the higher watts bulb/tube light in the video creation room.

Ring Light – 18 Inches.

You also get in 10 inches but they are not so effective
